From the Chair of Church Council

On behalf of Church Council March is election month for QUC, with the elections to be conducted at the Congregational meeting to be held on Sunday 24 March. The timetable for nominations was circulated in mid-February. We have a number of positions to fill so I continue to urge you to think seriously about serving QUC in this way.

At its February meeting, Church Council agreed that it would be desirable for QUC to reactivate its mission planning initiatives. The aim of this work would be to develop a Mission Plan for QUC which would outline what it means in practice to live out our objective of being a 'good news – good neighbour' church. A practical mission plan would assess what we are currently doing as a church in the Queanbeyan community and how this might be sustained and expanded into the future, within the constraints which we face in terms of congregation numbers, age profile and budget.

A Mission Plan would be a strategic document which would help us assess whether possible future initiatives are consistent with our overall goals and strategies. In addition to helping shape our future ministry, a coherent Mission Plan is a Synod requirement before any future property development can be undertaken. While there are no current property development initiatives before QUC, it is likely that further opportunities will arise in the future and it will be essential to have a Mission Plan against which to assess such proposals, that is, to determine whether such proposals are consistent with our overall strategy of being God's people in this region.

Ideally, Council would like to form a small working group to take this work forward in consultation with the congregation and taking into account the work that has been done previously. If you feel you would be interested in participating in such a working group please talk to Apelu, myself or any member of Church Council.

It was great to see the Jumble Sale and Shed start up again for 2024 on 24 February. These activities remain one of QUC's most significant contacts with the Queanbeyan community and are always happy days. On behalf of Council, thank you to all who work so hard to run these activities, including those who donate goods for sale and provide food for hospitality.


Bennie's Basket' Food Pantry
