The idea is to ensure we are aware of when people in the congregation are facing difficulties and to co-ordinate the provision of support and practical assistance where this would be helpful. Having specific pastoral carers also gives people someone to contact when they are looking for support. Pastoral care doesn't need to be a formal or onerous task. It is possible, for example, that the pastoral care group could simply meet once a month for coffee and a chat. If you think you could help out in this way, please contact Apelu or a member of Church Council.

Thanks to everyone involved in the working bee on 15 June, with a special thanks to Glen Crawley for co-ordinating the morning and to Alison Crawley who provided the very welcome morning tea. We managed to rake up and remove three ute loads of leaves (-that's a lot of leaves!-) as well as tidying up around the gardens and the car

park. The car park has been reconfigured to provide two disabled car spaces. The white posts in the disabled car space nearest the church are there to ensure there is enough room for people on walkers or in a wheelchair to access the path from the carpark to the church. Anyone using that car park should park as close as possible to the white posts; the posts have been positioned to ensure the car doors can be opened without hitting them.

22 June saw another very successful Jumble Sale and Shed and Council again expresses it's thanks to everyone involved in making these activities such a successful interaction with the local community.


The Team sort goods on a Tuesday morning. They are always keen to welcome new helpers.


